

## KENYA SWIMMING FEDERATION ANOCA SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA FOR TOKYO 2020

This selection criteria has been developed to enable Kenya Swimming Federation identify three (3) top swimmers to be considered alongside other athletes in the African continent for ANOCA Scholarships following an invitation (see attached) dated 20<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 by National Olympic Committee of Kenya (NOCK). According to NOCK, the scholarships are to support athletes towards medal finish at next year's Tokyo 2020 Summer Olympics.

The criteria for selection of the top three (3) eligible nominee is as follows:

- 1. Must be a Kenyan citizen.
- 2. If having dual citizenship, s/he must have declared Kenya his/her sporting nation and represented the country in the last one year.
- 3. S/he is not currently on any FINA or IOC scholarship.
- 4. Must be have the highest FINA Points in any one Olympic event.
- 5. The times in the database to be considered in the selection are those attained between 1st March, 2018 and 20th March 2019.
- 6. Must fill and return the Athlete Information Form by due date.
- 7. S/he is actively training and engaged in competitive swimming.

The application process is as follows:

- 1. CMC will shortlist the six (6) eligible swimmers from the database who meet the set criteria.
- 2. From the shortlist, CMC will invite the six (6) swimmers to fill and return the Athlete Information Form within one (1) day from the date of invitation.
- 3. The duly filled Athlete Information Form should be returned via shckenyaswimming@gmail.com on the due date accompanied by a signed recommendation letter from the swimmer's coach.
- 4. SHC will review the returned filled Athlete Information Forms and recommend the top three (3) swimmers based on FINA Points to be considered for the ANOCA Scholarship.

Kenya Swimming Federation shall be guided by this criteria and retain full and absolute discretion for selection of the swimmers to be nominated for the ANOCA Scholarship.
