



## **TENTATIVE SELECTION CRITERIA FOR 2020 OLYMPIC GAMES**

**LOCATION: TOKYO, JAPAN**

**COMPETITION DATES: 21-28 JULY 2020**

**TEAM SIZE: 2 (automatic nomination for FINA "A" Time standards Qualifiers)**

**ESTIMATED COST: Fully Funded Trip (NOCK & Ministry of Sports)**

### **1.0 OBJECTIVE**

The purpose of this document is to set out the criteria that will be used by KSF, Competition Management Committee (CMC) to select athletes and coaches for the 2020 Olympic Games Team. The objective of the CMC is to select a team of the Top ranked swimmers that will best represent the country at the Games.

### **2.0 ELIGIBILITY**

- i) A Swimmer must be able to represent Kenya in accordance with the eligibility requirement rules set out by FINA and on the first day of the competition must hold a Kenyan passport which expires no earlier than December 31, 2020;
- ii) A Swimmer must declare him/herself eligible for selection prior to April 1, 2020;
- iii) Selected Swimmers must sign the KSF Code of Conduct by May 1, 2020. Where the Swimmer is under the age of 18 years, the Swimmer's parent or guardian must also sign this agreement; and
- iv) Individual entries will be based on the event for which the athlete is selected. Relay team composition (if any) will be determined by the CMC and or the Team Coach based on achieved times and or performance during the event as the case may be. Relay entries are subject to FINA approval.

### **3.0 CRITERIA**

- (i) Automatic nomination for swimmers that have met the FINA "A" Qualifying time standards as per the FINA time standards:

- (ii) The times in (i) above to be used for selections must have been achieved at FINA qualifying events not earlier than 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019 and no later than \_\_\_\_ Day of \_\_\_\_, 2020 (TBC -date of Kenya National Swimming Trials);
- (iii) If no FINA "A" qualifying times have been achieved, the swimmers to be selected must have competed at the 2019 18<sup>th</sup> FINA Long Course World Championships, Gwangju, Korea to be considered for a Universality slot as per IOC and FINA Qualifying systems as provided in the following links:

- (iv) If no FINA “A” qualifying times have been achieved, the top ranked swimmer per gender based on the Top FINA points in their top Olympic event with a maximum of 1 swimmer per event from their performances achieved at the 2020 KSF National Swimming Trials scheduled to be held on TBC in Kasarani, Nairobi and subject to (iii) above;
- (v) Swimmers must participate at the 2020 KSF National Swimming Trials to be eligible for selection unless they have already achieved a FINA “A” time by the date of selection. Where 2 Swimmers have achieved an A time in the same event, priority will be given to the swimmer that participates at the Kenya National Swimming Trials;
- (vi) Where no swimmer has achieved a FINA “A” qualifying time, their nomination by KSF shall be subject to approval by FINA and shall be subject to (iii) and (iv) above ;
- (vii) Where no swimmer has achieved a FINA “A” time standard and swimmers who participated at the 2019 18<sup>th</sup> FINA LC World Championships in Korea have since become inactive, is injured, ill or for some other reason whatsoever is unable to compete or do not participate at the 2020 KSF National Swimming Trials, the top one ranked swimmer per gender based on FINA points in their top Olympic event with a maximum of 1 swimmer per event from their performances at the KSF National Swimming Trials but such nomination shall be subject to approval by FINA; and
- (viii) Subsequent achievement of a FINA “A” or “B” qualifying time or posting faster times with higher FINA points than the swimmers selected after the selection on (TBC) \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2020 shall not affect the team composition as confirmed.

#### **4.0 COMPETITIVE READINESS**

- i) “Competitive readiness” is defined as the ability of the athlete to achieve equal or superior performance(s) at the scheduled event, as compared to the performance(s) the athlete achieved in qualifying;
- ii) Athletes who do not remain competitively ready by reason of lack of fitness, injury, or illness may be removed from the team. Athletes and their personal coaches are required to immediately report any injury, illness or change in training that could affect their ability to compete at their highest level at the competition to the CMC in writing via email ([compmngt@gmail.com](mailto:compmngt@gmail.com) ).
- iii) The final decision on competitive readiness will be made in concert with the swimmers coach, the CMC, designated team physician or such other coach who may have knowledge of the swimmers specific circumstances.



## **5.0 REMOVAL OF SWIMMER**

- i) The CMC may, at any time, disqualify an athlete from being considered for selection to the Kenya Team or remove an athlete after selection based on current or past behaviour of the athlete that is inconsistent with KSF's Team Rules, Regulations and Code of Conduct;
- ii) An athlete will be removed from being considered for selection to the Kenya Team or removed after selection if he/she is found to be in violation of any anti-doping policy or procedure as outlined by Anti Doping Agency of Kenya, FINA and World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

## **6.0 UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES**

- i) Should the CMC determine that unforeseen or unusual circumstances have arisen during the process of applying these Criteria, the CMC shall have the full and absolute discretion to resolve the matter as it sees fit, taking into account factors and circumstances that it deems relevant.
- ii) Any such exercise of discretion shall be subject to the principles of fairness.

## **7.0 TEAM OFFICIALS**

KSF will in as much as possible ensure that there is a gender balance between Team Officials and Swimmers. Priority will go to Team Coach who will double in as Team Manager.

### **7.1 TEAM COACH**

To be eligible for selection:

- (i) Must be a fully registered coach and member in good standing;
- (ii) Must submit a current Certificate of Good Conduct by June 1, 2020;
- (iii) Have been resident in Kenya and duly employed as a swimming coach by a KSF affiliated organization/team/club for 90 days prior to the first day of the Selection;
- (iv) Must declare him/herself eligible for selection prior to June 1, 2020;
- (v) Must hold a Kenyan passport, which expires no earlier than December 31, 2020;
- (vi) Must have attained a minimum of Level 3 FINA Coach qualification or equivalent;
- (vi) Must have previous experience of having placed a swimmer(s) on the National team;
- (vii) Must have coached at least one swimmer on the 2020 Olympic Games team;
- (viii) S/he has no prior record of disciplinary action taken against her/him on matters regarding management of athletes or such other action; and
- (ix) Must sign the KSF Code of Conduct on or before June 1, 2020.

Swimmers shall be at liberty subject to any restrictions on accreditation by the Organizers/FINA to have their personal coaches attend the championships on condition that the swimmer shall cater for all the expenses relating to travel, accommodation, accreditation, kit, insurance or such other expenses that relate to the specific coach. The personal coaches shall be required to sign and comply with the KSF, Code of Conduct and all other rules and regulations set for the team officials.

### **7.2 TEAM MANAGER (Subject to number of slots granted by NOCK)**

- i) Must submit a current Certificate of Good Conduct by June 1, 2020;



- ii) Previous experience of managing a national team to an international competition of equivalent level;
- iii) Must be a Kenyan Citizen and hold a valid Kenyan passport which expires no later than December 31, 2020;
- iv) Must have a good understanding and technical know how of the Sport;
- v) Must have good and demonstrable administrative or other professional skills and experience;
- vi) Must have previous experience of having placed a swimmer(s) on the National team;
- vii) S/he has no prior record of disciplinary action taken against her/him on matters regarding management of athletes, minors or such other action; and
- viii) Must sign the KSF Code of Conduct on or before June 1, 2020.

### **8.0 APPEAL PROCESS**

Selection results from the CMC/IMC final selection will be published on [date TBC]. Appeal against non-selection by CMC must be made in writing within 2 days (48 hours) of the announcement of the athletes selected for the Championships, via email to [comptmngt@gmail.com](mailto:comptmngt@gmail.com)

The grounds for any appeal shall be:

- i) The athlete's omission was a result of a failure by CMC to properly apply the eligibility and selection criteria set out in this policy;
- ii) The athlete's omission was a result of a failure by CMC to adhere to the terms set out in this policy; and
- iii) The athlete's omission was a result of existence of fresh and compelling evidence and/or data, which had not been submitted, in the initial nomination.

The Interim Management Committee shall consider and deliberate the appeal and, if deemed justifiable, will hear the appeal by the athlete concerned and provide the final decision on or before [date TBC]. Any further appeal shall lie with Sports Disputes Tribunal.

The Competitions Management Committee and the Interim Management Committee shall have the full and absolute discretion for selection of the Team Coach and Team Officials.

The Competitions Management Committee and the Interim Management Committee reserves the right to amend these criteria and the amended criteria will be recirculated.
