



SELECTION OF KENYA'S REPRESENTATIVES TO THE 8TH FINA WORLD JUNIOR SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS, 30 AUGUST – 4 SEPTEMBER 2022, LIMA – PERU AND THE 15TH CANA CHAMPIONSHIPS, 20 – 25 AUGUST 2022, TUNIS – TUNISIA

1. 8TH FINA WORLD JUNIOR SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS

1.1 Championships Dates and Venue:

FINA will host the 8th Edition of the World Junior Championships from 30 August 2022 to 4 September 2022 at the Videna Aquatics Centre in Lima, Peru with the support of the Federación Deportiva Peruana de Natación (FDPN), the Host Federation. The Championships were slated for 24 – 29 August 2021, but postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In April 2022, FINA announced a change of dates as well as a change of host from Kazan, Russia to Lima, Peru due to the February 2022 Russian invasion of Ukraine.

1.2 Entry Deadlines:

According to the Championships Summons released by FINA, Preliminary Entries were due for submission through the FINA General Management System (GMS) by **21 June 2022** for purposes of confirming participation and indicating the total number of participants for each National Federation. Final nominations are to be entered in the FINA GMS not later than **19 July 2022**.

1.3 Qualifications and Entry of Competitors:

According to the FINA Championships Summons all FINA affiliated National Federations are eligible to participate in the Championships. **However, because of the current FINA suspension, Kenya's participation can only be under a neutral flag.**

1.5 Age Groups:

The Age Groups are the following –

- Girls: 14 – 17 years on December 2022 (born 2008, 2007, 2006 and 2005)
- Boys: 15 – 18 years on 31 December 2022 (born 2007, 2006, 2005 and 2004)

1.6 Quota Per Country:

Each National Federation may enter up to two (2) swimmers per event, and one (1) relay team, making a maximum quota of 26 women and 26 men.

1.7 Qualification Period:

The Entry Times accepted are those achieved within the qualifying period of 1 January 2021 and 17 July 2022

1.8 Eligibility to Participate:

A competitor must be a citizen by birth or naturalization of the nation her/she represents per FINA General Rule GR 2.5.

1.9 FINA Financial Contribution:

Each National Federation is responsible for their team travel, accommodation and meals expenses. However, FINA will provide financial contribution for a maximum of three (3) swimmers and one (1) coach entered to participate at this Championships as follows:

- Africa: - up to USD 1,625 per person
- Asia: - up to USD 1'820 per person
- Americas: - up to USD 585 per person
- Europe: - up to USD 975 per person
- Oceania: - up to USD 1'625 per person

The financial contribution will be provided only after the conclusion of the Championships.

1.11 Selection Criteria

Selections for eligible Athletes will be based on the following criteria:

- Meeting the eligibility requirements set by FINA as summarized above;
- Highest FINA points collected; and
- Availability of the Athletes.

1.13 Coach Selection:

A public call was published on the KSF website on 12 June 2022 inviting interested coaches to express interest by 1 July 2022, with the following eligibility criteria:

- a) Must be a registered coach and member in good standing; Prior experience of having placed a swimmer(s) on the National team is an added advantage;
- b) Must apply within the allocated deadline by submitting a fully completed form and providing all the necessary attachments;
- c) Must hold a valid passport, which expires no earlier than 31 December 2022;
- d) Must not have past, current or pending disciplinary action taken against them on matters of conduct regarding management of athletes or such other action; and
- e) Must sign the Code of Conduct and the Duties and Responsibilities of Team Official on or before the set deadline of 01 July 2022 - 12:00 am and provide any other documents as may be required.

Only 1 application was received from **Coach Abdulmalik ABDULKARIM**.

1.15 Funding Requirements

The FINA financial support indicated in para 1.9 above covers only 3 athletes and 1 Coach, which might require top up. The funds will be splits equally between the 4 nominated athletes and Coach. The athletes will be required to top up the difference. Confirmation of the nomination is subject to acceptance of the aforementioned terms by the Athletes or their Parents/Guardians.

1.16 Disclaimer:

The FINA Stabilization Committee appointed to oversee the KSF affairs relied on the KSF database and information which is presumed accurate.

2. 15TH CANA CHAMPIONSHIPS

2.1 Championships Dates and Venue:

The 15th CANA Championships will be held over 5 days for Swimming from 20 – 24 August 2022 in Tunis – Tunisia (venue to be confirmed). A 5k Open Water Swimming Race will conclude the Championships on 25 August 2022. (Venue and details to be availed by CANA and the Tunisian Swimming Federation.)

2.2. Entry Deadlines:

Preliminary Entries were due for submission by **31 May 2022** for purposes of confirming participation and indicating the total number of participants for each National Federation. Final nominations are to be communicated not later than **1 August 2022**.

2.3 Qualifications and Entry of Competitors:

All CANA affiliated National Federations are eligible to participate in the Championships. **However, because of the current FINA suspension, Kenya's participation can only be under a neutral flag.**

2.4 Quota Per Country:

Each National Federation may enter up to two (2) swimmers per individual event, and one (1) relay team.

2.5 Eligibility to Participate:

A competitor must be a citizen by birth or naturalization of the nation her/she represents per FINA General Rule GR 2.5.

2.6 CANA Financial Contribution:

Aside from the travel costs which vary, accommodation is expected to cost USD 110 per person per day in a Twin Room and USD 130 per person per day in a Single Room. CANA has not offered any contribution or subsidy for this Events. Each Athlete is therefore responsible for meetings the costs of their travel, accommodation and meals expenses.

2.7 Hotel Accommodation:

The Championships Hotel is yet to be confirmed.

2.8 Selection Criteria

Selections for eligible Athletes will be based on the following criteria:

- Meeting the eligibility requirements set by FINA as summarized above;
- Highest FINA points collected; and
- Availability of the Athletes.

2.10 Coach Selection:

- a) Must be a registered coach and member in good standing; Prior experience of having placed a swimmer(s) on the National team is an added advantage;
- b) Must hold a valid passport, which expires no earlier than 31 December 2022;
- c) Must not have past, current or pending disciplinary action taken against them on matters of conduct regarding management of athletes or such other action; and
- d) Must sign the Code of Conduct and the Duties and Responsibilities of Team Official on a date to be determine, and provide any other documents as may be required.

Coach Fakhry MANSOOR meets the above criteria.
